REMEMBERING ROSE D'COSTA MBE

Rose D'Costa MBE SPARTA Honorary Life Member

It is with deep sadness that we report the sudden death of honorary life member, Rose D'Costa MBE.

Rose worked in the Department of the Environment and Transport in the original 2 Marsham Street building, starting work in the typing pool and progressed over the term of her career through to the role of Senior Personal Secretary (SPS).

Rose has been heavily involved with SPARTA since its beginning in 1972. Rose was also one of the founding members of the Ten Pin Bowling club and league which also started in 1972.

Rose was married to Peter D'Costa. Rose's husband, Peter, is a formal general Secretary of SPARTA, and organised many sports days.

At these events Rose would be in charge of the very popular raffle and she along with Peter raised hundreds of thousands of pounds for charity through these and many other charity raising events with the majority of their monies going towards the Charity for Civil Servants (formally the Civil Service Benevolent Fund).

Rose and Peter were both recognised for their charity work,



each receiving an MBE in 1997.

Rose, together with her husband, were involved in the corporate games and attended with teams formed from both DfT and DLUHC (in their various previous incarnations) many times. They were both very proud to represent our Departments at these events.

We know that many of you will have fond memories of Rose and we would love to share those memories with our members so we will be setting up a special commemoration webpage for Rose.

My own personal memory of Rose is of the many times that she coaxed me into buying raffle tickets but how pleased she was when I finally won a special wine set in a commemorative box. I still have it today.

CYGNET ROWING CLUB






Looking to try out a new sport or get fit?

You too could get to mess about in boats on the Thames by joining up on their six week course.

The course will get you started in every aspect of rowing.
